fascist or quasi fascist movement 2 the new right as a challenge to dichotomy which has structured european political debates for more than 200 years 3 the new right as an alternative modernist movement which rejects liberal and socialist narratives of modernity accepts the technical but not political or cultural effects of modernity and longs for a pan european political framework abolishing liberal multiculturalism and privileging ethnic dominance of so called original europeans and 4 the new right as a variant of political religion and conversionary process the book concludes by analysing the positions cultural and political impact and relationship to democracy of the new right this work will be of great interest to students and scholars of racism fascism extremism european politics french politics and contemporary political theory
